Postoperative Instructions for Adenoidectomy

- 1. Drink plenty of liquids and eat soft foods. You may advance diet as tolerated.
- 2. **NO** bending, lifting, or straining for three (3) days.
- 3. You may use Tylenol and/or Ibuprofen for pain as needed.
- 4. **NO** aspirin or Aspirin-containing products.
- 5. Ear pain or discomfort may be expected after an adenoidectomy. It will resolve.
- 6. Low-grade fevers, less than 102 degrees Fahrenheit are very common after an adenoidectomy. High, prolonged fevers should be reported.
- 7. Please contact the office within one (1) or two (2) days of discharge from the hospital or surgery center to schedule a postoperative appointment. (Office telephone number: 610-376-9728, prompt 2 from a touch-tone telephone).
- 8. Please contact the office if bleeding occurs or if you have any other concerns.
- 9. In the event of a medical emergency call 911 or go directly to the Reading Hospital and Medical Center Emergency Room.
