## Postoperative Instructions for Rhinoplasty

- 1. Leave the protective splint on your nose in place. It will be removed 4 or 5 days after surgery. Keep the splint and tape dry while bathing.
- 2. Expect blood to ooze for one (1) to two (2) days.
- 3. Elevate your head while sleeping.
- 4. Swelling starts to resolve in two (2) to three (3) days. Apply ice packs to your cheeks fro 20-minute periods throughout the first two (2) days. After two (2) days apply moist heat to your cheeks.
- 5. No bending, lifting, or straining for the first seven (7) days.
- 6. Do not take aspirin or Aspirin-containing products for (1) week.
- 7. Do not blow your nose. Sneeze with your mouth open.
- 8. Take your pain medicine and antibiotics as directed.
- 9. Clean the dry crusting from your nostrils twice daily with Q-tips and peroxide. After cleaning, apply over-the-counter antibiotic ointment inside each nostril with Q-tips. If external sutures are present, apply antibiotic ointment to them, as well.
- 10. Use Afrin nasal spray as follows: two (2) sprays in each nostril three (3) times per day for three (3) days only.
- 11. Spray over-the-counter saline nose spray in each nostril every two (2) hours while awake. This will moisten your nose and help decrease crusting.
- 12. Please contact the office one (1) or two (2) days after discharge to schedule a postoperative appointment [610-376-9728].
- 13. In the event of a medical emergency call 911 or go directly to The Reading Hospital & Medical Center Emergency Room.
