## <u>Postoperative Instructions for</u> <u>Tonsillectomy and/or Adenoidectomy</u>

- 1. Drink plenty of liquids and eat only soft foods for 14 days after surgery.
- 2. No bending, lifting, or straining and no exercise or sports for 14 days after surgery.
- 3. You may use Tylenol and Ibuprofen for pain. You may alternate Tylenol and Ibuprofen every 2 hours if necessary.
- 4. Your doctor may prescribe pain medicine. If so, take only as directed on prescription.
- 5. No aspirin or Aspirin containing products.
- 6. Ear pain or discomfort may be expected after tonsillectomy. It will resolve.
- 7. Your throat will have thick white patches where your tonsils were removed. This will disappear with healing. It is not an infection.
- 8. Low-grade fevers, less than 102 degrees F, are very common after a tonsillectomy. High, prolonged fevers should be reported.
- Please contact the office within one (1) or two (2) days of discharge from the hospital or surgery center to schedule a postoperative appointment. [610-376-9728].
